

Position Title CPM Vice-President Research and Standards

Position Summary: CPM VICE-PRESIDENT RESEARCH AND STANDARDS (VPRS) is responsible for a range of strategies and practices used by the CPM to identify, create, represent, distribute, and enable adoption of project controls body of knowledge in general, and earned value management in particular, that can be used by the CPM members.

The body of knowledge will include areas such as, research, gap analysis, project control standards, policy formulation, industry standards, best practices, literature and emerging theories and practices.

The CPM VPRS is responsible to establish strategies and maintain policies, and tools for effective Project Controls Research and Standards. The CPM VPRS responsibilities include:

- Manage CPM Project Controls Research program
- Manage the Practice Symposia for the EVM World and IPM Conferences
- Monitor developments in Project Controls standards globally

General Requirements:

- Understand the CPM's organizational structure, Strategic Plan and Business Plan and how it fits within CPM's strategic/business objectives
- Understand and commit to CPM's objectives and goals around increasing member value and knowledge delivery
- Be familiar with CPM's annual program plan and budget cycle
- Possess knowledge and understanding of basic nonprofit fiduciary responsibilities, which include CPM's Code of Ethics and Professional Conduct, and Conflict of Interest and Confidentiality
- Be familiar and support CPM's By-Laws and Guidelines
- Must attend all board meetings (minimum of two per year)
- Ability to work with persons of all cultures, backgrounds and global significance.
- Ability to work both independently and in a team-oriented, collaborative environment
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Must be a member of CPM

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

The CPM VPRS coordination and management activities require an individual with strategic planning, coordination, and communication skills within the CPM and other industry / professional / educational organizations related to project controls

Leadership KSA's include:

- Prior leadership with project control and EVM knowledge management as defined above
- Ability to employ knowledge management gap analysis problem solving techniques
- Ability to effectively prioritize and execute tasks
- Ability to use information technology to enhance knowledge management

- Monitor project control and EVM research, trends, standards, emerging theories and best practices
- Analyze and develop analytic reports on project controls knowledge management
